Encore Boston Harbor | Health & Safety Plan

In accordance with Governor Baker's May 28, 2021 Executive Order rescinding most remaining COVID-19 restrictions in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts effective as of May 29, 2021, Encore Boston Harbor intends to return to pre-pandemic operations, based upon business demand, as more specifically set forth below. At all times, Encore Boston Harbor will comply with the guidance, regulations, advisories, and protocols issued by the CDC, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the Massachusetts Gaming Commission and the Department of Public Health.

1. Face Coverings:

Encore Boston Harbor will adhere to CDC guidance and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health's Advisory Regarding Face Coverings and Cloth Masks: https://www.mass.gov/doc/advisory-regarding-face-coverings-updated-3122-0/download

Per CDC and State guidance, mask guidance is based on the COVID-19 Community Level. The three levels are:

2. Exposure and Symptoms:

Guests should not visit Encore Boston Harbor if they have been exposed to, or have any symptoms associated with, COVID-19.

3. Health and Sanitation Program:

Encore Boston Harbor will continue to promote hygiene for guests and employees. Encore Boston Harbor employees have all received mandatory training for disinfection and safety protocols and will continue to implement, as necessary. Encore Boston Harbor will continue to provide and maintain hand sanitizers and disinfectant wipe dispensers throughout the entire resort and gaming area. Encore Boston Harbor will continue enhanced cleaning protocols including the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of all public spaces, with an emphasis on frequent contact surfaces both front- and back-of-house. In the event of a presumptive case of COVID-19, Encore Boston Harbor will remove a guest room from service until the room can be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.
